Note of Resolutions Passed at October 2003 Meeting, held on Wednesday 15th October 2003 at Tockwith Village Hall

In Mrs Firth's absence, Cllr C Billenness recorded resolutions passed at the meeting

1. Minutes of Previous Meeting

The Council unanimously approved the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 10th September 2003.

2. Matters Arising

The Council noted the inspection report of the Marston Road Play Area.

The Council resolved to ask Mr Dodsworth to repair the gate, replace links and overspray graffiti as necessary.

The Council noted recommendations relating to signposting and flagstones but resolved to take no action on either of these owing the low risk which arose.

3. Church Allotments and Tenancies

The Council resolved that persons on the waiting list to receive allotments be given 28 days to decide whether they wished to take up vacant allotments, and then be permitted another 28 days to begin to working the allotment. If they fail to meet either condition, then they will be deemed to be no longer interested and the allotment to be passed to the next person on the waiting list.

The Clerk to be instructed to administer the waiting list on this basis and to re-contact all persons on the waiting list annually to ask them to confirm that they wish to remain on the list.

4. Tockwith Community Fields

The Council resolved to support the application from the Sportsfield Trust to release £9,613 of commuted sum monies towards work to develop additional playing field space.

5. Quality Council

The Council resolved to no longer formally pursue an application to become a Quality Council but to continue its long-standing policy of aspiring to the standards of a Quality Council
