5. To appoint members to the Neighbourhood Development Plan Committee

RESOLVED: To appoint Sue Corbett and Chris Everson as members of the Neighbourhood Development Plan Committee.

6. To consider the Terms of Reference for recommendation to full Council

The Terms of Reference were discussed and amended. **RESOLVED:** To recommend the amended Terms of Reference for approval at the next full Council meeting.

7. To note the Designated Area

It was noted that the combined parishes of Tockwith, Cowthorpe and Wilstrop have been designated as a Neighbourhood Area.

It was noted that although Cllr McHenery is the Parish Council's representative for Wilstrop, effort should be made to ensure the residents of Wilstrop are aware of the NDP.

8. To consider the Community Engagement Day, including dates, times and responsibilities.

RESOLVED: That there will be two Community Engagement Days, Friday 19th June 2026 3:00-7:00pm and Saturday 11th July 2026 10:30am-3:00pm. Both events will be held in the Garden Room at Tockwith Village Hall.

RESOLVED: To recommend to full Council that an initial budget of £1000 is set to help with the costs of running the Community Engagement Days.

The following points were agreed:

- The aim of the Community Engagement Days is to learn about Tockwith, Cowthorpe and Wilstrop, how people feel about the parishes and potential development in the future. We are looking to build an evidence base to support the visions, aims, policies and themes of the NDP.
- Clerk to contact NYC to ask for a map of the parish in the scale of 1:10000 and 1:25000.
- Jamie will arrange for two-three copies of the map to be printed in A1 layout.
- Jamie will draft a survey which will be printed and delivered to all households. The NDP Committee will obtain three quotes for printing and/or delivering. An online version will also be available. This will be available for approximately four weeks, with the Community Engagement Days being held roughly in the middle of this period.
- Jamie will design a poster to advertise the Community Engagement Days. The poster will be printed by the NDP Committee and also be shared on the Parish Council's Facebook and website.

- Three or four volunteers are required to help capture members of the public's views each day.
- Jamie will provide a prompt sheet to help with discussion points.
- The NDP Committee will gather a list of all the community groups/clubs etc who may have an interest in the NDP. This includes those that live/work/use community facilities.

The next meeting of the Neighbourhood Development Plan Committee will be held on Monday 1st June at 7:00pm at Tockwith Village Hall.
